Sarah McLachlan brings her friends along for her November tour



Only a month since LILITH 2010 came to an end, Sarah McLachlan is ready to get back on the road. The Grammy-Award winning singer/songwriter has announced a special fall tour launching Monday, November 1 in Dallas. The "Sarah And Friends" tour will be one unlike any other, with shows consisting of two sets: one set with Sarah sitting in on songs by her guest performers, and a second set of Sarah's greatest hits and new favorites from her recently released and critically-acclaimed album, *Laws Of Illusion*.

"Sarah And Friends" will also have an interactive element as Sarah answers audience questions intermittently throughout the performance. Fans will have the opportunity to submit questions upon their arrival, which Sarah will then choose randomly from the stage.

This summer's Lilith tour saw Sarah rejoin new and old friends on the road, and her live performances were among the best in her career. In a live review of the Los Angeles-area Lilith tour date, the Los Angeles Times raved "McLachlan ...was almost levitating with radiant energy," the Hollywood Reporter observed, "Sarah isn't just back. She's better," and the Orange County Register said Sarah was "at her finest."

Of her first album of brand new material in 7 years, USA Today raves: "Some of her most buoyant and beautifully crafted songs ever. Candid and thoughtful, *Laws Of Illusion* finds her tackling heartache head-on and leaves no doubt that she wants to find love again – and will." And The New York Times glows: "The songs are as direct as Ms. McLachlan's have ever been, and as finely tuned...The album is as lush and measured...It's a collection of ballads, hymns, and waltzes, sung in long arcs of melody with a voice that enfolds its strength in breathy intimacy. Acoustic instruments gleam, with unearthly keyboards and electric guitars billowing up around them."

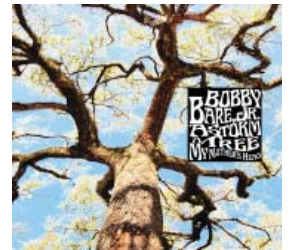

Sneak a peek at these critical raves for Bobby Bare Jr.

"Oscar Wilde once mused that "life imitates art," but on Bobby Bare, Jr.'s sixth album, *A Storm, A Tree, My Mother's Head*, art imitates life. The thirteen song collection, which took the Nashville rocker four years to write and release, plays like a short autobiography of its author, with titles like "Your Goat is On Fire," "Swollen But Not the Same," and "Liz Taylor's Lipstick Gun" alluding to Bare's unusual but sharp sense of humor, and more somber tunes like "The Sky is the Ground" and the record's title track reminding listeners there's a serious, personal side to the man behind it.

On "A Storm, A Tree, My Mother's Head," Bare sings of an incident that almost left his mother dead in 2008, resulting in one of his most solemn, gripping songs to date. Throughout the album, traces of working man's rocker Bruce Springsteen can be heard, while an at-times-subtle undercurrent of Nashville country runs through courtesy of growing up living and writing with his father, Bobby Bare, Sr.

Those echoes of Bare, Sr., are justified, too, as the Nashville legend lent his songwriting talents to three of the album tracks, including closers "But I Do" and "But I Do (Walk Off Music)." Another highlight of the album is "Lost in a Puzzle," which features co-writing credit from the record's co-producer David Vandervelde as well as collaboration from My Morning Jacket's Tom Blankenship, Carl Broemel and Patrick Hallahan. Bringing in elements of friends and family, the playful and the profound, the record is Bare's most personal to date, and, accordingly, also one of his best. Rating: 4 stars - American Songwriter



"Four years after his last full-length, Bobby Bare Jr. returns with a package of deeply personal alt-country numbers. Whether he's singing about scorn in "One Of Us Has Got To Go," the urgency of nearly losing his son in "The Sky Is The Ground," or reflecting on the near death of his mother in the title track, Bobby Jr. isn't afraid to bare his soul on an album full of emotional upheavals and settling downs. Rating: 84% - Filter Magazine

"Bobby Bare Jr.'s new record is a boozy alt-country romp that truly shines at its heartbreaking best. Signature tracks like "One of Us Has Got to Go" and the album's namesake are evocative ruminations on being alone, albeit in disparate circumstances. It's obvious from the onset of the album that Bare undoubtedly has a gift for wordplay and lyricism, but once in a while it works against him. While *A Storm – A Tree – My Mother's Head* is laden with unmistakable songwriting gems, they make the odd indulgent piece of filler all the easier to spot. "Lost Jesus Sandals," for example, proves to be a subject not worthy of four and a half minutes.

Still, though a little uneven, the album redeems itself by being chock full of relatable landscapes overflowing with cheap beer ("Rock and Roll Halloween") or '90s grunge nostalgia ("The Summer of '93"). What perhaps defines the album is the anticipation of oncoming heartbreak that colors songs like "Sad Smile" and "But I Do." Occasionally, a steel guitar makes an appearance to really accent the sad bastardism of Bare Jr.'s plight, but it's a plight we've all indulged in and would be more than happy to share a drink over. Rating: 3 1/2 stars - Venus zine
